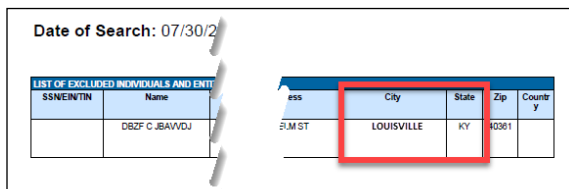

Production Fix

Misplaced City and State Data in PDF Created of LEIE Matches

Issue: When a user selected [Save/Print Results Summary + Selected Details] for an LEIE match through *Online Search*, the City and State data were displaying in the wrong columns in the PDF, despite displaying correctly in the user interface.

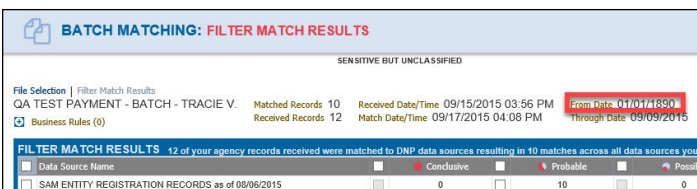
Resolution: City and State data display in the correct columns.



Release Enhancements

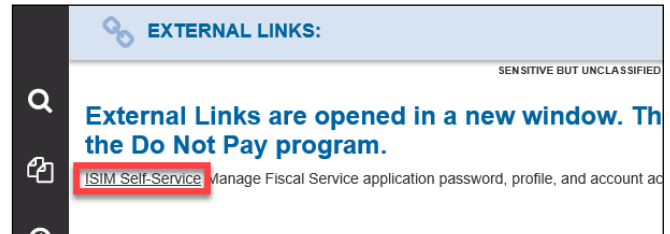
From Date Removed from *Batch Matching* and *Continuous Monitoring*

Description: The From Date label and value are no longer shown on the *File Selection* pages of *Batch Matching* and *Continuous Monitoring*. Only standard *Batch Match* files contain a valid date for this field, and confusion resulted from the default date of 01/01/1890. (There is no screen shot for *Continuous Monitoring* as it is very similar to the *Batch Matching* screen.)



ITIM Name Change to ISIM

Description: The IBM Tivoli Identity Manager (ITIM) has been changed to IBM Security Identity Manager. (ISIM). Users will now see ISIM in the place of ITIM within the Portal.



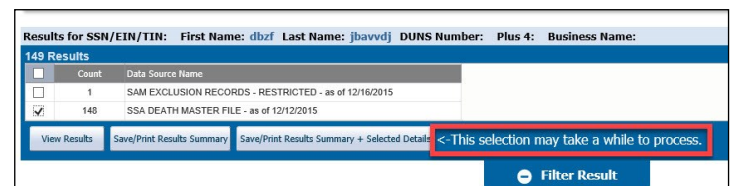
Online Search Pagination and Navigation

Description: If there are more than ten matches against a data source in *Online Search Results*, users will now see these results paginate and will be able to use a navigation bar to go to specific pages.



Online Search Print/Save Summary and Results Warning Removed

Description: Users will no longer see the process warning which appeared next to the [Print/Save Results Summary + Selected Details] button on the *Online Search: Display Results* page if 25 or more matches were selected. The warning is no longer necessary due to performance improvements with PDF creation.



Online Search Performance Improvements

Description: Users will experience performance improvements within all *Online Search* activities, including searching, viewing search match results, and saving/printing search match results.
